

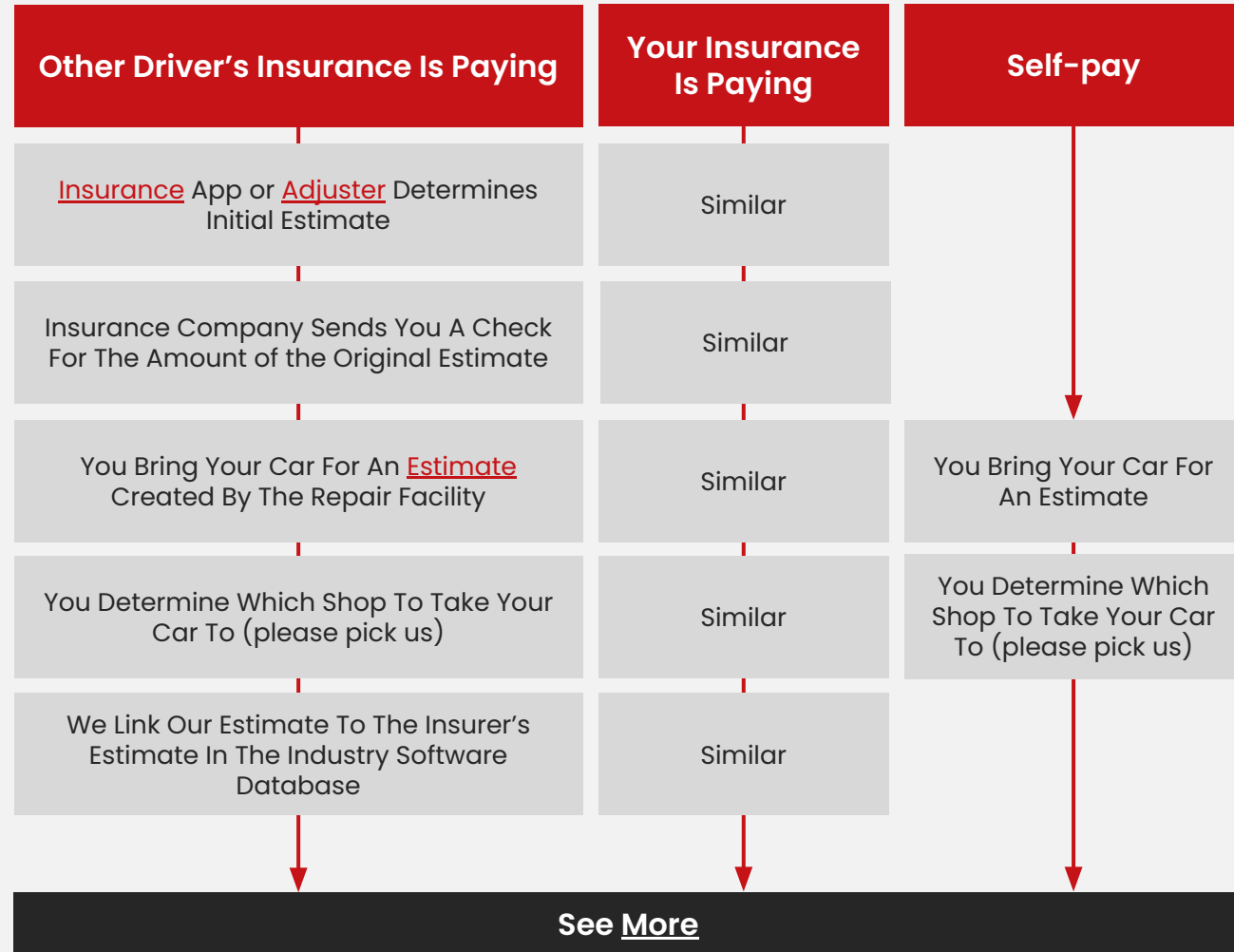


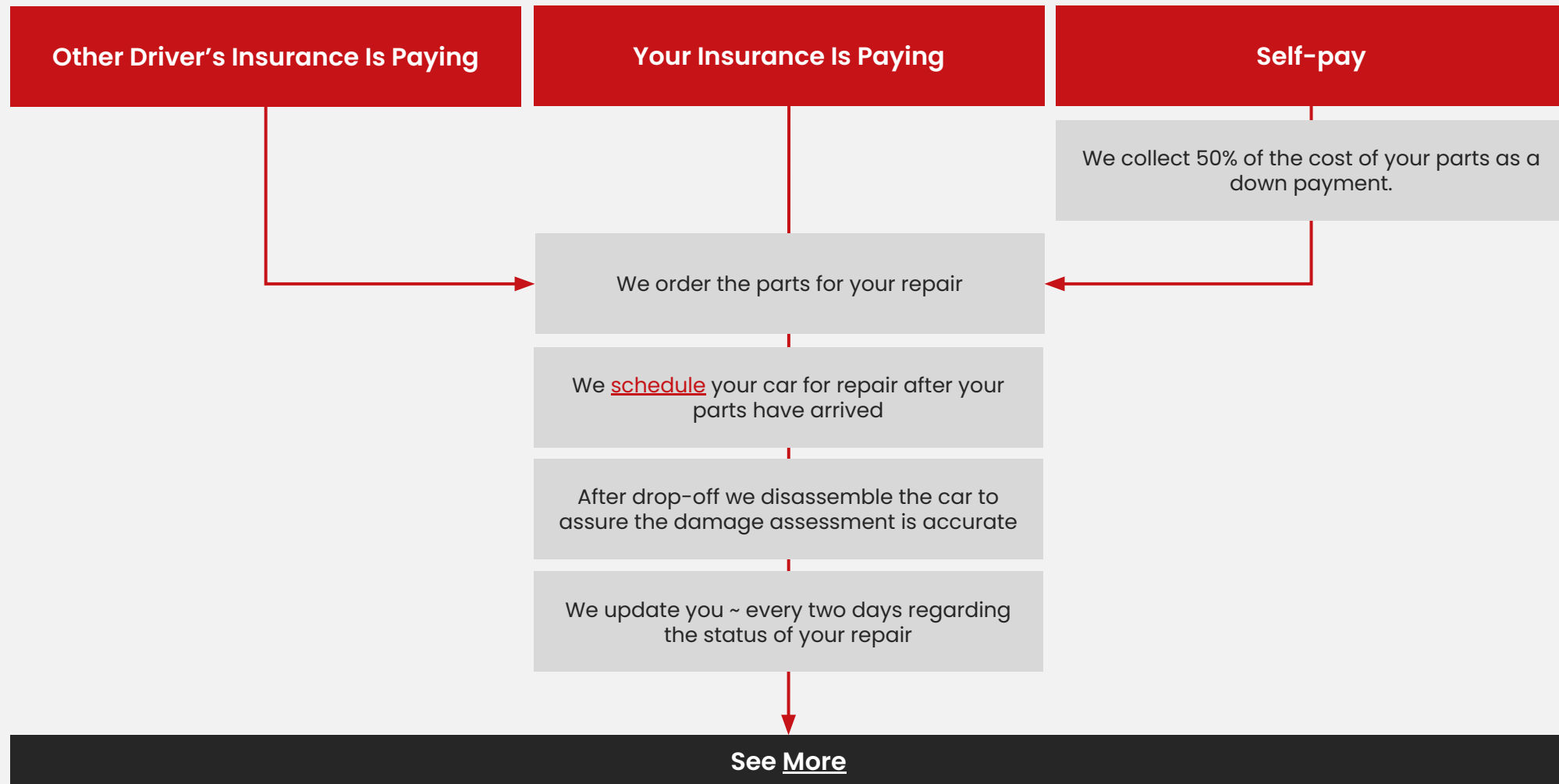

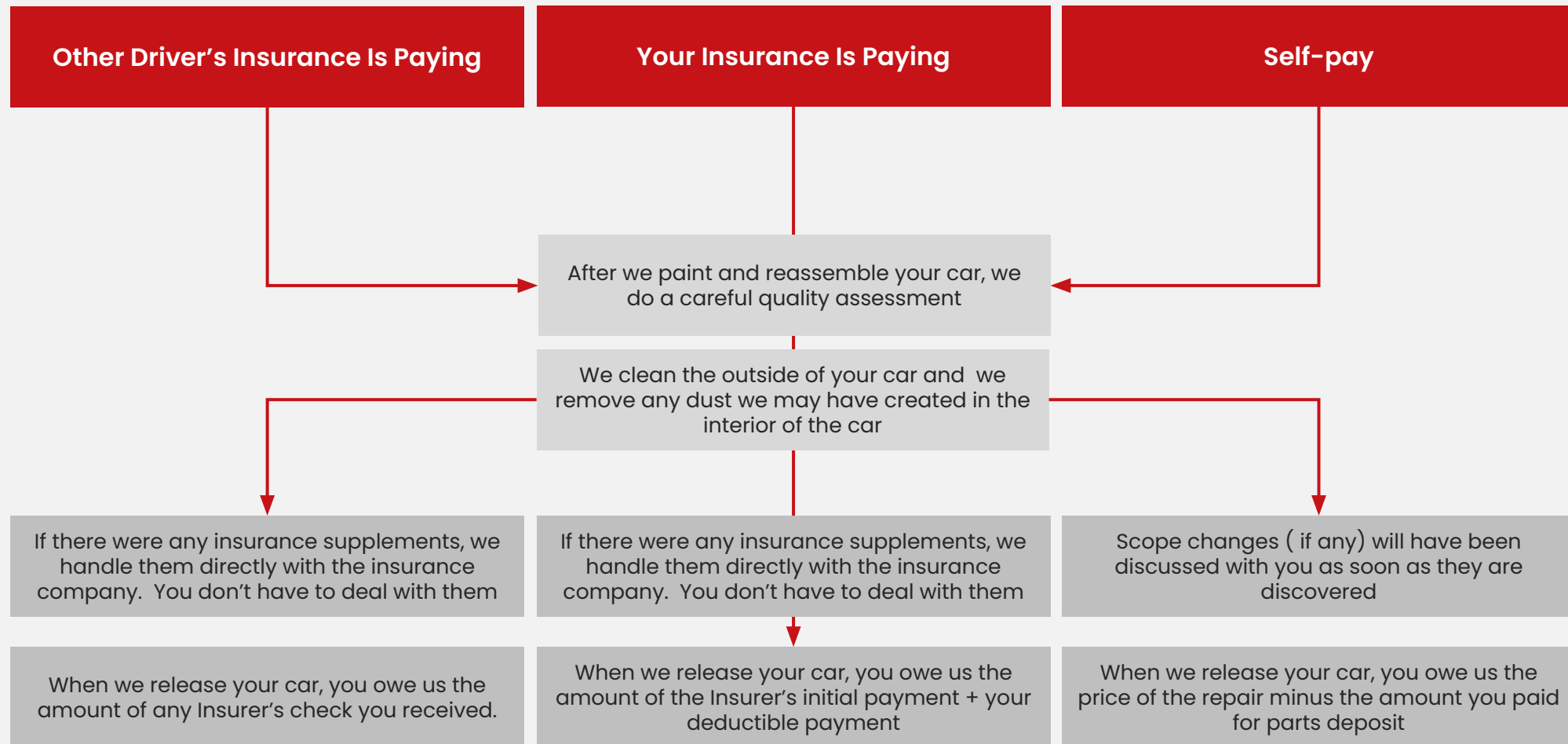
Three Paths For Your Car Repair

Note:

If there is any damage to your car that you would like repaired that is unrelated to the accident, we can take care of it while we are working on your car. We will write that up as a separate Repair Order







INSURANCE APP

If you have not already loaded your insurance company APP on your phone, they will likely ask you to do so as a 1st step in dealing with your damaged car.

Most APPs will have a menu item or button that says something like Start A New Claim.



- The APP will walk you through the directions for taking photos of the whole car and especially the damaged area.
- Once you close the claim menu on the app all your photos will be uploaded to the cloud and queued for an assessor working for your insurer to prepare the insurer's initial estimate.

Adjuster/Estimate

If the cloud-based assessor thinks your repair is simple they will issue you an estimate based on what they can see in the photos.

– You can take that estimate to any body shop for your repair.

If the cloud-based assessor believes this is a more complex repair, the insurer will assign an adjuster to come do an in-person inspection of the car. The adjuster will then write the insurer's estimate at that time.

– If the car is at a tow yard or already at a shop, the adjuster will go to where the car is to do this inspection. You should not have to have the car moved to any specific place to be inspected.

Once you receive an estimate, you can take it to any shop for your repair.

– The shop will also create an estimate based on their observation of your damage. If the shop finds any damage that was not observed by the adjuster, the shop will contact the insurer and resolve the differences. You Do Not Have To Deal With This Step.

Schedule

We will order the parts for your car once we are authorized to begin. We work with our suppliers to get good quality parts delivered as quickly as practical.

- We won't settle for an inferior part just because it can be delivered more quickly.

We will determine when all the parts are promised to be here and schedule your repair to start at that time.

- If your car is still drivable, there's no point having it sit at the shop until the parts are present to do the repair.

- We want to minimize the number of days you are without use of the car.

- We want to minimize the number of days you are in a rental car.

2. Your estimate should list each part and repair process as a separate line item so the total repair cost comes with complete transparency

 - *how long we think it will take for your parts to come in*
 - *when we can schedule you for the repair*
